Sussex County E-Waste Disposal Day:

Saturday, October 14th - Drop off your electronics at the Sussex County Municipal Utilities Authority Electronics Waste Disposal Day, 7 AM - 2 PM, **34 South Route 94, Lafayette**, New Jersey 07848. Examples include: computers, printers, cell phones, televisions, VCR's, DVD & CD's, fax & copiers, radio & stereos, etc. Limits: Up to 5 units *per vehicle*. Scale charge for larger quantities

As previously advised, Televisions, Monitors, Printers, FAX machines, Copiers and Desktop and Laptop Computers may no longer be placed curbside for bulk pick-up, and consequently **will not** be picked up. Please use the following link for more information: [E-Waste Collection Day](#)

2017 Fredon Township Bulk Pick-Up



Bulk Pickup is provided for all residential dwellings located on roads regularly serviced by garbage haulers.

All Bulk pickup will be on **THURSDAY** on the **date designated below, but may continue into Friday**. Items may be put out as early as the Sunday before the bulk pick-up date, but no sooner. It **ABSOLUTELY** must be put out the **NIGHT BEFORE** the pick-up date - pick-up begins at **5 AM**.

Bulk pick-up is **not** being picked up by your garbage hauler, so please do not **ASSUME** that if your garbage is still out there the bulk pick-up hauler has not been through the area. Permitted items not picked up must be held by the residents for the following month's pick-up.

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS ONLY!

Interior household bulk items such as stoves, refrigerators, furniture, carpets, etc., but not normal **household garbage or bagged garbage**. Building material, construction debris, outdoor items and tires will not be picked up! Bulk pick-up is not intended for whole-house clean-outs - please contact a hauler for a dumpster if needed.

~If it is small enough to fit in a garbage bag or can it is **NOT** bulk~

Effective January 1, 2011, the following items may no longer be placed curbside for bulk pick-up:

Televisions, Monitors, Computers, and Laptop Computers. Additionally, effective on January 31, 2017 the following items have been added to the list of items prohibited to be placed curbside for bulk or regular pick-up as they may no longer go into the regular waste stream:

Printers, FAX machines and copiers.

The New Jersey Electronic Waste Management Act bans the disposal of these electronic devices and mandates that they be recycled. These items may be recycled at the following locations: SCMUA Collection Programs - Regular Operations (scale charges apply), Scheduled free annual recycling events, or New Jersey Manufacturers and Retailers.
